1 Corinthians 3:1-23 Matthew 20:20-28

1 Corinthians is a pastoral letter, written to resolve doctrinal and practical problems within the local church. If we would analyze this letter carefully, we find that Paul responds to 10 separate problems;

- A sectarian spirit
- · Incest
- Lawsuits
- Fornication
- · Marriage and divorce
- Eating food offered to idols
- Wearing the veil (head covering)
- The Lord's supper
- Spiritual gifts
- The resurrection of the body

How does the Apostle Paul address all these problems at once?

He reminds the church that they have to rediscover the true foundation, which is Jesus Christ, as a counter to all human boasting.

The purpose of our church is summarized in a single sentence based upon two key Scriptures:
