Read Isaiah 55:8-9

- What does it mean to submit to God Almighty?
- What should we do when God doesn't answer our prayers right away?

Read Isaiah 55: 10-11

What is God telling us about His doctrine in these two verses?

1. From being a Favorite to a Foreign Slave

Genesis 37:1-36

- Why do you think Jacob made Joseph a tunic of many colors?
- What was Joseph's relationship with his father?
- What was Joseph's dream(s) about and was it showing something for the future?
- What causes jealously between Joseph and his brothers?
- Could Joseph have prevented this jealously? Why or why not?
- Do you think everyone notices that Joseph had some special gifts and do you think Joseph knew he had some special gifts?
- Was God teaching Joseph something in his early life?
- As you look back, has there been a time in your life when God was teaching you something which impacted your future? Did this strengthen you?

2. From Being a Slave to Being a Prisoner *Gen 39:1-21*

- Did God use Joseph's captivity for good?
- What strengths/gifts did it take Joseph to resist Potiphar's wife?
- How did God use Joseph when he was falsely accused by Potiphar's wife?
- Does God favor ill willed prosperity? Why or Why not?
- Have you ever been falsely accused? How did you handle it?
- How did Joseph keep "above reproach?"
- How do you live your life when there is adversity?
- Do you think God is preparing you for better things in life?

3. From Being a Prisoner to Being Prime Minister

Genesis 41:1-46

- What did Joseph mean in Genesis 40:8; "Do not interpretations belong to God?"
- How did God work in Joseph's life during his time in jail?
- Why do you think Joseph gained Pharaoh's trust?
- Are you allowing God to use you each and every day no matter where you are in your life?
- Have you ever said to God, Why me? What have you heard back?
- Joseph showed patience as he suffered major road blocks in his life.
 Do you see God with you when you have road blocks in your life?
- Why do you think God had so many "delays" in Joseph's life? What can we learn from this?
- Is it easy for you to "keep the faith" and rest your hope upon God?
- When you find yourself in a part of your life that is "tough" is it easy to allow God to use you?

4. From Being Prime Minister to Being a Provider

Genesis 45:1-11

- What was Joseph's perspective on what his brothers did to him when he was young?
- What do you think his brothers were thinking when Joseph identified himself and then said do not be grieved or angry with yourselves?
- Have any hurtful events molded your life?
- Is it easy for you to be "like Joseph" after a hurtful event in your life? Why or why not?
